TITLE: Resolution Introducing Local Law 2 -2020 "Town of Farmersville Drinking Water Protection Law"; Referring Proposed Local Law to County Planning Board; Authorizing Supervisor

WHEREAS, Pursuant to section 10 of the municipal home rule law, the Town of Farmersville may from time to time enact such local laws as it deems necessary; and

WHEREAS, placed on the desks and delivered to each Councilman and the Clerk is Local Law 2 - 2020 entitled "Town of Farmersville Drinking Water Protection Law"; and

WHEREAS, prior to adoption by the Town Board, a series of actions are required; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, there be introduced Local Law 2 - 2020 entitled "Town of Farmersville Drinking Water Protection Law" on this date, January 6, 2020; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to refer proposed Local Law 2 - 2020 to the Cattaraugus County Planning Board for review and feedback as required by Section 239-m of the General Municipal Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Supervisor is hereby authorized and directed to sign and submit all required documents, applications, contracts and the like for the required Environmental Assessment Form, Environmental Impact Statement and State Environmental Quality Review processes required by Law; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the Town of Farmersville will serve as Lead Agency for purposes of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), designates this a Type I Action, and hereby authorizes the Town Board and/or the Attorney for the Town to carry out all required actions; and be it further

RESOLVED, that a public hearing shall be held on the proposed Local Law 2 - 2020 by the Farmersville Town Board on the 13th day of January, 2020, at 7:01 p.m. at Farmersville Town Hall, 8963 Lake Avenue, Franklinville, NY, and that at least five (5) days notice of such hearing shall be given by the Clerk by the posting thereof upon the bulletin board in the Town Hall and by publishing such notice at least once in the Olean Times Herald.
