- SECTION 1. PURPOSE: The Town of Farmersville is a small rural township in the northeast section of Cattaraugus County. Its tax base is small, and its population is under 1,028 people. Its town highway system of approximately 47 miles was not constructed to accommodate todays' vehicles with heavy loads. As a result in order to maintain and repair said highways the Town faces very large costs which it cannot afford. Therefore, this local law is necessary to avoid further extensive highway damage by limiting the weight of vehicles to a total of no more than eight (8) tons.
- **SECTION 2.** No vehicle weighing more than eight (8) tons shall be operated on any Farmersville Town Highway, except for the pick up or delivery of any merchandise or commodity to any customer located on a Town Highway.
- **SECTION 3.** A. Vehicles owned by the Town may exceed the weight limit herein stated since this is for the benefit of the public at large such as for snow removal or highway repair, but not necessarily limited thereto.
- B. Also vehicles owned by public utilities such as electric, gas, telephone and cable companies may exceed the weight limit since this is also for the benefit of the public.
- **SECTION 4.** The Town shall post all Town Highways with signs of this weight limitation as prescribed by the manual for sign posting established by the State of New York.
- **SECTION 5.** Any violation of this law shall be punished by a fine \$100.00 for the first offense; \$200.00 for the second offense occurring within 18 months of the first offense and \$500.00 for any subsequent offense.
- **SECTION 6.** This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the New York Secretary of State.
