Hwy Report

The department has been working on black topping Reynolds Rd and will be working on Pigeon Hill but will be closing that part of the road when working on it, they were given an extension on the cleanup behind the hall till 9/30/2020

Old Business

Mr. Lounsbury reported that the Intervenor funds had been approved for the Town

A motion was made to accept the code enforcement's report by Mr. Westfall and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried

New Business:

Mr. Tingue presented to the board another quote from George and Swede for Hyandi loader – has 2.75% to 3% financing,

Mr. Westfall would like to see a proposal on a purchase agreement for a loader

Mr. Tingue stated that on the subject of the outside building, does not want to add on to the building not the objective he is working towards - Mr. Lounsbury stated that the board would make some decisions next month

A motion was made by Mrs. Tilton to bid out the liability insurance and seconded by Mr. Heberling, carried.

A motion was made by Mr. Lounsbury to advertise for a justice and to have all letters of interest in by end of September and seconded by Mrs. Vickman, carried

Mr. Westfall asked Mr. Tingue if he could have some more proposals on some different kinds of buildings for next month.

Mrs. Vickman asked about the status with the water district for the State DPW

Mrs. Tilton asked if Town Attorney Mr. Firkel was on the line and he stated he was, she asked why the paperwork about the depositions for herself and the town clerk was dated July 7th but wasn't sent to either of them till August 6th, she stated that more time should have been given to them, and Mr. Firkel stated that he would do better with that.

A motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:56pm by Mr. Lounsbury and seconded by Mrs. Tilton, carried.
